A carbon neutral future

We believe in doing our bit to help tackle climate change here at EMC and are constantly looking at ways in which we can reduce our carbon footprint.

Over the last year we have introduced various energy saving initiatives, greener policies and have offset those unavoidable emissions by donating to A Rocha and Climate Stewards Ghana Project. This project plans to offset 154,000 tonnes of CO₂ through five years of tree planting by the local people. A mixture of kapok and mahogany trees are planted in Kumansi and Damongo and will not only absorb carbon but also provide food, medicines and valuable fibre for the local community.
